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Psalm 9:10

And they that know Thy name will put their trust in Thee: for Thou, Lord,
hast not forsaken them that seek Thee.

♦ Did you know His name is Jehovah-jirah?

Definition—The Lord will provide

The Lord will foresee and provide

Passage—Genesis 22

- v.1-2 God asks Abraham to sacrifice Isaac on one of the mountains in the land of Moriah
- v.3 Abraham rose early next morning
Didn't delay obedience—although hard request
- v.4 3 days saw place afar off
- v. 5-6 Abraham left servants and he and Isaac went on with wood, fire, knife
- v.7 Isaac asked where's the lamb—**picture of obedience and trust**
- v.8 Abraham answered **God will provide Himself a Lamb**
went on together
- v.9-10 Abraham built altar....put wood in order
- v.11,12 Abraham stopped by an angel
- v.13 Ram caught by horns—**couldn't be blemished**
Ram offered in Isaac's place
- v.14 Jehovah-jirah—In the mount of the Lord it shall be provided

Application

God provides all I need!

All = spiritual, physical, emotional, etc

Spiritual—Salvation—ram took place of Isaac

Jesus took my place on the cross

Romans 8:32

Physical—My God shall supply all my need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus

Philippians 4:19

Makes provision ahead of time for the trials and testings we face

Extra Verses

Exodus 12:3-11, 27

Genesis 4:4

Hebrews 10:18

♦ **Did you know His name is Jehovah-Shammah?**

Definition The Lord is there; eternal presence of the Holy One

Passage—Psalm 23:4a—Ezekiel 48:30-35

Ezekiel 48:35—It was round about eighteen thousand measures:
and the name of the city from that day shall be, The LORD is there.

Application

Ezekiel foretold the destruction of Jerusalem, prophesied of its restoration.

Most precious promise that believers have had in all ages is the presence of God

Eternal presence to Moses—Exodus 3:13-14

Seen in the pillar of cloud and fire

Crossing of the Red Sea

Dedication of the Temple

Holy Spirit indwells us today and will remain until we see Jesus

Ezekiel's prophecy looked to the new Jerusalem where Jehovah-Shammah will be, and His very presence will be the light of the city

♦ **Did you know His name is Paraclete?**

Definition=person who steps forward to represent another one called alongside to help

Comforter = the Holy spirit, called alongside to help, console, guide into the truth of God's Word

Passage—Psalm 23:4b—John 14:15-27

John 14:16—And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you Another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever.

Comforter = sweet Spirit of God

Cares for us as Jesus did when He was on the earth

Application

When Jesus ascended to the Father, He said that He would send "another" Comforter of equal quality—John 14:16

Taken up Christ's office in this age

Same compassion

Same loving care

Same desire to relieve our hearts of worry, pain, trouble

Consoles our weary hearts

His work is to carry on Christ's ministry

Help us pray

Comforts in grief

Concerned for our pain

He's attached a promise—I will not leave you comfortless—John 14:18

◆ **Did you know His name is Friend?**

Definition—Friend—Psalm 23:5a,c—Proverbs 18:24; John 15:13-15

Passage—Proverbs 18:24.....there is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother.

John 15:13-15—no longer servants but His friends

Application

Precious to think that the Lord Jesus considers us His friends
How many times is that sweet fellowship broken? Yet, He calls us
friends and always desires and seeks our restoration!

◆ **Did you know His name is Hope?**

Definition—Hope—Psalm 23:6a

Hope = trust refuge, shelter

Hope = Feeling of expectation and desire for a certain thing to
happen, feeling of trust; Expectation of good

Passage

**Jeremiah 17:7—Blessed is the man that trusteth in the Lord
and whose hope the Lord is**

Joel 3:16—Lord will be the hope of His people and the strength of
the children of Israel

1 Timothy 1:1—Jesus = Our hope is in the Person of Jesus Christ,
not in ourselves or anyone or anything else

Application

Without Jesus the world is without hope

He is our hope, life, peace, righteousness because all blessings
come from Him

◆ **Did you know His name is Abba?**

Definition—Daddy

**Passage--Galatians 4:6-7—Because ye are sons, God hath sent forth
the Spirit of His Son into your hearts crying Abba, Father**

Matthew 14:36—(In Garden of Gethsemane) Jesus prayed, Abba,
Father

A sacred name

Romans 8:15—Not given a spirit of bondage again to fear

Has give a spirit of adoption whereby we cry Abba, Father

Application

Child of God represented as crying child to his Heavenly Father
Term slaves could not use
As sons and daughter of God we can call Him Abba Father in times
of prosperity or adversity!

♦ **Did you know His name is El Roi?**

Definition—The Strong One Who Sees

The One who sees our troubles, gives comfort and direction; who
sees our actions and the motives of our hearts

Passage—Genesis 16:1-16

- v.1 Sarai not been able to have a baby
- v.2 Sarai suggested Abram take Hagar her servant and allow
her to bear his child in Sarai's place
- v.3-4 Abraham agreed, and Hagar conceived
- v.5- Sarai is treated badly by Hagar
- v.6 Abraham gives Sarai the authority to deal with Hagar
Sarai treats her harshly and Hagar leaves
- v.7-12 An "angel of the Lord" comes to minister to Hagar
Promises her that her son will be father of great nation
Tells her to go back to Sarai and Abraham
- v.13 Thou God seest me—El Roi
God saw her trouble and ministered to her and met her need

Application

God sees me!
No matter where I am or what I'm doing
He knows my every need.
He understands my hurts and fears
Yet He directs me to do what is right even if it is difficult
He directs me through His Word to find the promises we
need to sustain us
Job 31:4—He counts my steps
He alone is able to judge us righteously, even our secrets
Romans 2:16

♦ **Did you know His name is El-Shaddai?**

Definition—God Almighty

The All Sufficient Mighty One
Used 250 times in Scripture

Passage—Genesis 17:1-8

- v.1 Abram was 90 years old
Lord appeared to him
I am the Almighty God
- v.2 Made a covenant with Abram
Will multiply his family
- v. 3 Abram fell on his face before God
- v.4-5 God promises that he will be father of many nations
Changed name from Abram to Abraham
- v.6-8 Promises Abraham will be fruitful
Canaan for everlasting possession
He will be the God of his people

Application

Nothing in this world can truly satisfy me
 God is my sufficiency, Strength, satisfier
 He is the one who makes our efforts fruitful
 Genesis 28:3
 He is the One who nourishes, gives strength, and satisfies
 No need that He cannot supply
 What God promises He will supply

♦ Did you know His name is **Adonai**?

Definition—Lord

Signifies ownership of Lordship, Master

Passage—Genesis 15:1-6

- v.1 God speaks to Abram
Declares Himself to be Abram's shield and exceeding great reward
- v.2 Abram calls God by this name
Lord God
- v.3-5 Abram questions God plan for his heir
God promises that it would not be A's servant, but a true heir
Family would number like the stars of heaven
- v.6 Abraham believed the promise of God

Application

Pictures Servant and Master relationship
 Master has right to complete obedience
 John 13:13
 Servant has right to direction in service
 Isaiah 6:8-11
 Purchased servants
 Member of the family
 Could enjoy the blessings of family protection affection
 Exodus 12:43-45
